

Bioresonance

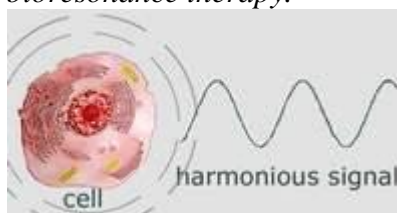
Bioresonance is the field of energetic medicine that detects and works with electromagnetic frequency information generated by the body. Bio refers to a living organism and resonance means 'to vibrate in harmony with'.

It has been shown that cellular radiation produces a minute electric current. This is responsible for communication between our cells and all the adaptive functions we take for granted. The human body is regulated by electromagnetic frequency information often referred to as an information field.

This information field differs between a healthy person and a sick person. Also oscillations from foreign substances stored in the body such as bacteria, viruses, toxins and so on have a different structure to that of healthy cells.

Research in Europe over the past several decades shows that the electromagnetic wave profile of harmful substances can be cancelled out by sending the opposite oscillations into the body. Manipulating the wave patterns into precise patterns to negate or strengthen the electromagnetic profile of various aspects of a person is the basis for this therapy. It has been used in Europe for over 23 years with great success. In fact, this healing modality has become the number one holistic tool in Germany.

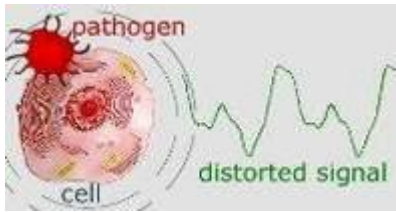
The following illustrates in a simplified way the basic concept behind toxin elimination using bioresonance therapy.



If a cell is in good health its minute electrical signal will be harmonious and resonate in a free manner with other cells in the body. For the purposes of representation we draw it as a sine wave. It's not but we can draw it as one.



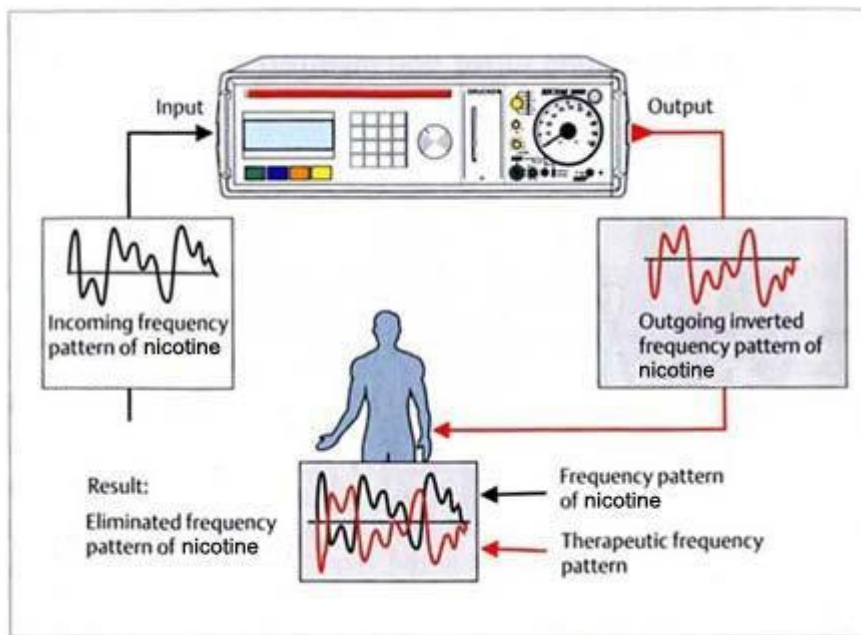
A pathogen such as nicotine has a different electrical signal from that typically found in human cells.



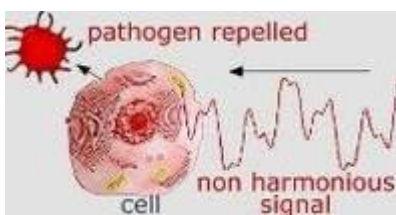
If a pathogen such as nicotine invades a cell then the signal coming from the cell becomes distorted.



The distorted signals coming from damaged cells are a combination of the original harmonious signal and a second non-harmonious signal caused by the pathogen.



In Bioresonance therapy an input electrode attached to the body is used to detect these minute cellular electrical signals and feed them into the therapy unit. The unit then separates the harmonious from the non-harmonious.



The bioresonance unit then mirror images the non-harmonious signal and feeds this back to

the body as a therapy signal. This signal has the effect of repelling the pathogen or toxin from the cells so the body can then eliminate them from your system.

Bioresonance therapy has been used in Germany for the past two and half decades. There are currently around 6000 'BICOM 2000' devices being used in Germany, two thirds of which are owned by doctors.
